For information about the Diploma Course in Dialysis Technology offered by DM Hospitals Pvt. Ltd.

A. Regarding the preservation of original mark sheets and certificates of the candidates during the admission process.

1. Admission Requirements for Diploma in Dialysis Technology:

Eligibility Criteria: To enroll in a Diploma in Dialysis Technology, candidates typically need to have completed a 10+2 or equivalent with a background in Science (preferably with Biology, Physics, and Chemistry). FOR DM HOSPITALS PRIVATE LIMITED

Documents Required:

- o Mark Sheets (Class 10, Class 12, and any other relevant educationabirector documents).
- o Proof of Age (such as a birth certificate or passport).

o Identification Proof (Aadhaar, Passport, etc.).

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- Passport-size Photographs.
- o Medical Fitness Certificate (for some courses).

You may need to submit original documents for verification at the time of admission to verify your eligibility.

2. Preservation of Original Documents at DM Hospitals Pvt. Ltd.:

1. Timing of Withdrawal:

- Early Withdrawal (usually within 15 days of the course) may entitle you to a partial refund of the course fees.
- Late Withdrawal (usually after 15 days of the course) may result in no refund.
- Refund Deduction:
 - o Administrative Fees: An administrative fee for processing the withdrawal, which may be deducted from the refund amount.
 - o Course Materials: If you have already received study materials or other resources, the cost of these items may be deducted from the refund.
- Refund Timeline: Refunds may take a three weeks or more to process after the withdrawal has been approved. FOR DM HOSPITALS PRIVA

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2. Conditions for Withdrawing from a Course and Refund Process

3. Refund Terms

- Withdrawal within 1–7 days of starting the course: A partial refund, usually 50% of the fees.
- Withdrawal within 7-15 days into the course: A partial refund, usually 25% of the fees.
- Withdrawal after 15 days or mid-course or at the end: No refund issued.
