The **Jalpaiguri Government Engineering College**, abbreviated as JGEC, is a premiere public engineering institution established in 1961. It is situated in the Jalpaiguri, the divisional headquarters of the eight districts of North Bengal. The university offers bachelor's degrees (B. Tech) in six branches and master's degrees (M.
